**Instructions for fingerprinting:** Make sure hands are clean, especially the tips of the fingers. Place this card on a hard, smooth surface. Use a small amount of tape on the bottom to keep it from sliding. Practice on plain paper a few times. Lightly press one finger onto a standard black ink pad. Line up finger with correct box below. Press straight down firmly, adding a little pressure over the cuticle. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ROLL THE FINGERPRINT!** Even experienced fingerprinters have trouble doing this with small children. Wipe off the finger you have just done before proceeding to the next one. If your child gets a little unruly, wait until they are calm before continuing.
